[Am I Eligible?](#)

To participate in the Cool Savings Rebate Program you must be an Ontario resident or business (with residential-type systems).

To qualify for the Central Air Conditioning (CAC) system, furnace and/or programmable thermostat rebates, you must:

- Already have a CAC system or furnace installed in your home. Unfortunately, people who don't have CAC systems or furnaces do not qualify for this rebate.
- Purchase the system and have it installed by a participating contractor.
- Have the system installed between January 1, 2010 and December 31, 2010.
- Your contractor must enter your online rebate by January 10, 2011 and the proof of purchase (invoice copy) must be sent in no later than February 1, 2011.

Make sure you keep a copy of your invoice for your furnace, CAC system and/or programmable thermostat in case you need it for repairs under warranty.

Once we receive your proof of purchase, it will take 4 to 8 weeks for us to process your rebate and mail it to you (provided the rebate is approved).

Tell Me More About The Rebates!

Rebates are available for residents and businesses (with residential-type systems) of Ontario who purchase and install their new central heating or cooling equipment through a participating contractor.

- **\$25 rebate** when you replace your old non-programmable thermostat with one that is programmable and have it purchased and installed by a participating contractor.
- **\$125 rebate** when you have an existing furnace replaced with the purchase and installation of a mid or high-efficiency furnace with an Electronically Commutated Motor (ECM).
- **\$250 rebate** when you have an existing central air conditioner (CAC) replaced with the purchase and installation of an ENERGY STAR qualified CAC system, heat pump or ductless split system (NOTE: ENERGY STAR qualified criteria = minimum 14.5 SEER and 12 EER).

\$400 rebate when you have an existing CAC replaced with the purchase and installation of a stand-alone CEE "Tier 2" level central air conditioning system or ground source heat pump.

How to Claim your Rebate

Follow these five easy steps to make sure you receive your rebate:

1. Your participating contractor will complete your online rebate form and ensure that all equipment serial and model numbers are included (final date for your contractor to submit is January 10, 2011).
 2. Once your participating contractor completes the online form, an email will be sent asking you to review your rebate details online
 3. Approve the rebate details as outlined on your online rebate submission
 4. Send in your proof of purchase (copy of your invoice) and copy of online rebate form by one of three methods: via email, fax or by mail (if you choose to send in via mail, we recommend sending it via registered mail).

2. Receive your rebate cheque in the mail within 4 to 8 weeks of the receipt of your proof of purchase (provided the rebate is approved).
